

REMEMBER...

- Extreme caution with children, don't let them out of your sight.
 - The use of soap is prohibited.
 - It is not allowed to use motor vehicles, camping or accessing with dogs at the beach.
 - Do not bathe immediately after a copious meal.
 - If you feel any discomfort, get out of the water as soon as possible.
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- Do not leave valuables on the beach while bathing or walking.
 - Always swim parallel to the coast.
 - Use an adequate sun protection cream and avoid sunbathing during the hottest hours.
 - Sunbathe gradually. The first day should not exceed ten minutes. Increase your exposure moderately.
 - Keep the beach clean.

- Give priority to people with reduced mobility.
- To avoid accidents, DO NOT invade the beacon lanes.
- Locate the Rescue and First Aid Stations. Respect the flags.

- * An Accessible Point is located near the Central Post, offering:
- * Amphibious beach wheelchairs and crutches for people with reduced mobility
- * A shaded accessible area
- * A flexible walkway adapted to the shoreline
- * Assisted bathing service (from July 1 to September 15, daily)
